Report on a special meeting called to decide the future of the Club

TOOWOOMBA PHILATELIC CLUB.

A special meeting of the above club convened for the purpose of deciding whether the club should be carried on or not, was held at the Downs Tea Rooms last Tuesday, the 17th, inst. The members present were :—Messrs Tanner, Booth, Provan, Robertson, Sloman, Bennett, and the Hon. Sec. It was decided that the Club should remain in existence, but that meetings should be held quarterly, in October, January, April, and July, not monthly as heretofore, with a view of giving members a better opportunity of obtaining duplicates for exchange purposes. The Secretary's report and Treasurer's statement showing a credit balance of 9s 8d, were adopted. Officers for the ensuing year were then elected, viz. : President, Dr. McDonnell ; Vice-presidents, Messrs. H. Stephens and Tanner ; Committee, Messrs Booth, Robertson, and Sloman ; Auditor, D. J. Provan ; Hon. Secretary and Treasurer, Mr E. R. Thomas. It was decided to obtain Gibbon's new catalogue to be issued shortly ; also Gibbons's Journal, Scott's Catalogue, and the Australian Philatelist.
