

ST. CHRISTOPHER - NEVIS - ANGUILLA

A study of all the stamps first issued by St. Christopher - Nevis - Anguilla during the 1950's decade.

All the known issued stamps are featured and are displayed in chronological order of their issue.

George VI Definitives.

The first issue of the combined entities governed by the newly formed Legislative Council featuring King George VI portrait and various scenes depicting life on the islands. Issued 1952. Features a double rate registered cover to England. cover

QE11 Coronation.

A single issue celebrating the coronation of Queen Elizabeth 11. Issued 1953.

Featured are examples from the two plates used in printing and a commercial local rate cover.

QE11 Definitives.

A set of fifteen issued in 1954 featuring the portrait of QE11 and landscapes, buildings and maps of the islands. Included is a commercial airmail cover to U.S.A.

Alexander Hamilton Bicentenary Commemorative.

A single commemorative to mark the bicentenary of the birth of the islands most prominent forefather. Issued 1957 to pay the increased 24 cent airmail rate to U.S.A.

British Caibbean Federation.

Issued 1958 to commemorate the founding of the The West Indies Federation.

The exhibit contains the Bradbury Wilkinson Imperforate Archive, the only known example.
