




CAMOOWEAL – The most westerly settlement in Queensland, eight miles from The border with the Northern Territory.



BURKETOWN – The earliest Post Office in this study, opening in 1866.



DONALDSON – 55 miles north-west of Cloncurry, the Post Office officially opened in 1895 and closed in 1911, when Granada opened 15 miles to the south.


CLONCURRY – Post Office opened four years after gold and copper were found locally in 1867.



OORINDI – East of Julia Creek on the Great Northern Railway, Post Office opened in 1916.



GILLIAT – West of Julia Creek on the Great Northern Railway, originally called Gilliat Crossing. Post Office opened in 1916.



JULIA CREEK – The most easterly Post Office on the GNR covered in this study, opening 1910.
